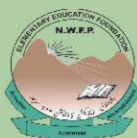
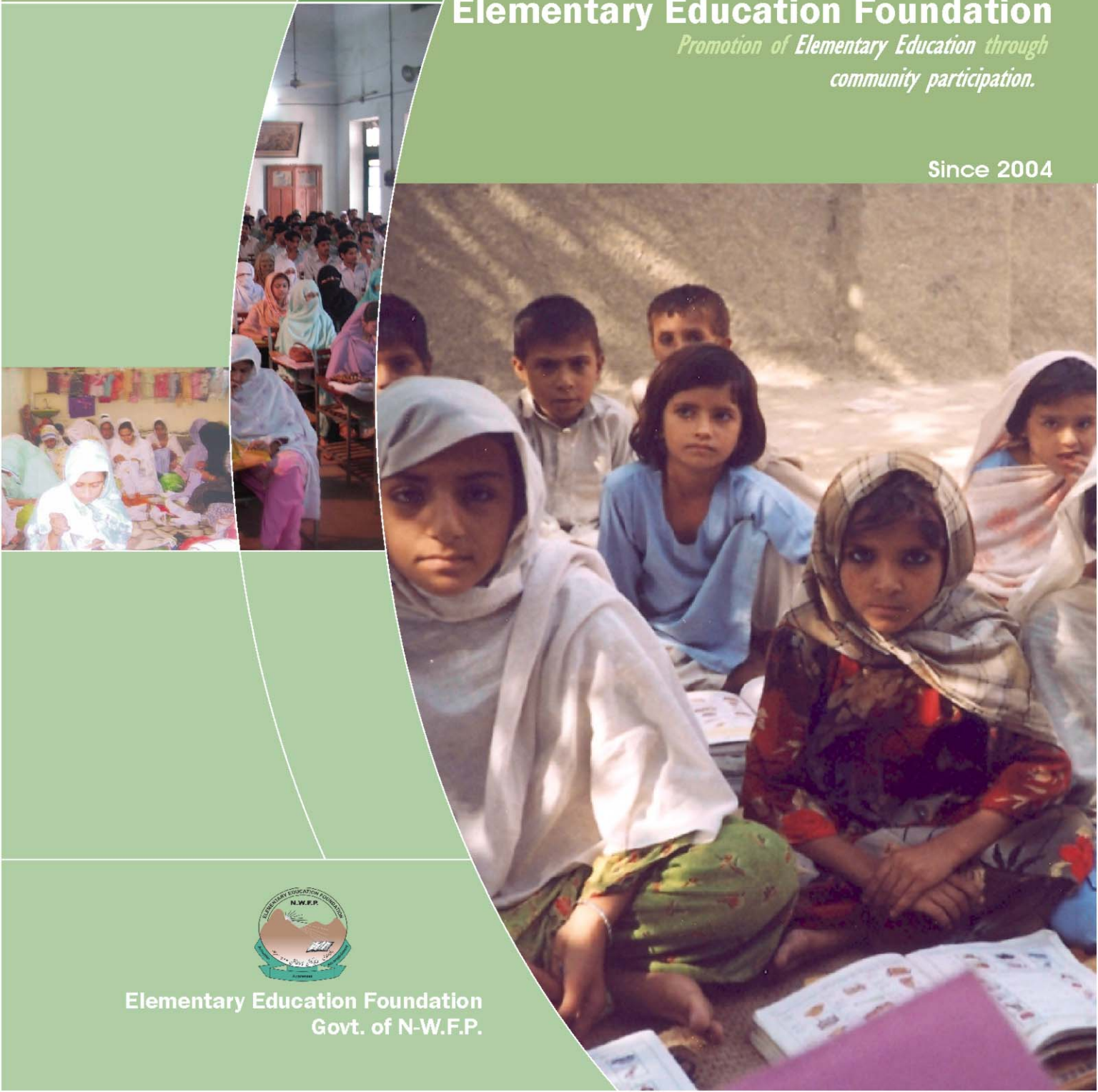

Current Activities / Projects

1. Projects Run by EEF own resources

- EEF Girls Community Schools.(200 Schools established since 2004)
- Community Learning Centers (CLCs). (15 CLCs - 3 batches of 6 months duration have been completed.
- Private Educational Institutes Teachers Trainings Program (PEITP). Total 5,700 teachers trained since 2005.
- Provision of additional/feeder teachers to government girls schools in deficient areas. (50 Teachers)

2. Annual Development Plan (ADP) approved projects

- Literacy For All (LFA)
 - Adult Literacy Programme.
 - Literacy Centers established 51,959 since May 2005.
 - Learners passed out 1.1712 million.
 - Project scope 24 districts of N-W.F.P.
 - Target age group 10 to 39 years (male & Female).
 - Batch duration 5 to 6 months. (Three hours a day).
 - Ten (10) Batches completed eleventh (11th) in progress.
 - Establish through Community Social Organizations (CSOs).
 - Number of literacy teachers trained 51,959.
 - Pool of master trainers in adult literacy, Need assessment & community mobilization.
 - Third Party Validation (TPV) of LFA passed out Learners.
- Mufti Mehmood Public School Dera Ismail Khan. (English Medium upto Secondary Level, for boys & girls)
- Swabi Model School Kotha Swabi. (English Medium upto Secondary Level, for boys & girls)

3. Completed Projects

- Established an English Language Laboratory at Provincial Institute for Teachers Education (PITE) N-W.F.P.
- Scholarship scheme (Rs.2.13 million were paid to 308 students in earth quack affected areas in 2006-07.
- Construction of Bacha Khan Model School, Buner. (Funded By Norwegian Government) completed in Sep, 2009.





Introduction

Elementary Education Foundation (EEF) was established under "The North West Frontier Province Elementary Education Foundation Ordinance 2002"/ Act 2004. It started operating in 2003-04. It is a body-corporate. The management has been vested in the Board of Directors which is headed by the Chief Minister NWFP. There are five official and five co-opted members from the civil society.

Elementary Education Foundation is headed by Managing Director who is member cum Secretary of the Board of Directors.

Mission statement

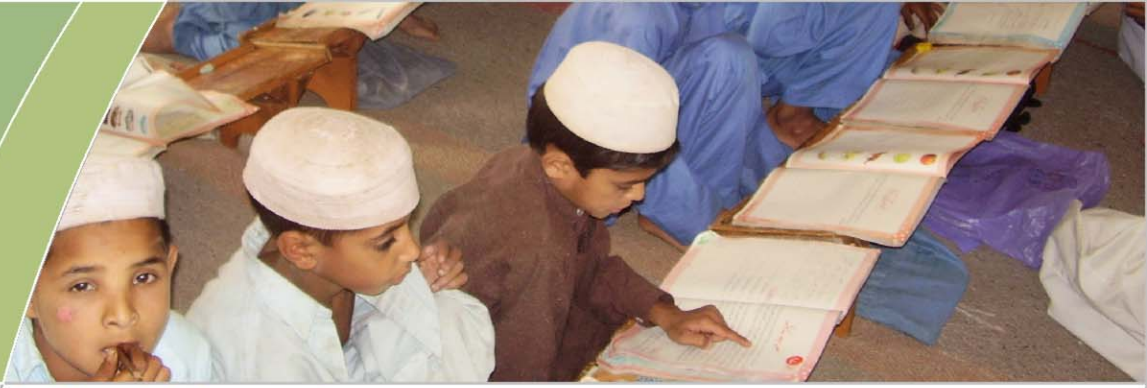
"To promote the elementary education through community participation and to supplement the government activities with the help of non-governmental educational institutions"

- To streamline the education imparted in religious institutions and madaris and mosques.
- To introduce innovative programs of adult literacy and skills for retarded people.
- To promote social, functional literacy and post literacy.
